The Montpellier innovation ecosystem now has its own address.

Just a stroll away from the train station and city's central Place de la Comédie, the Montpellier French Tech Building is the meeting place for innovation stakeholders. It is a place for exchanging ideas, comparing experience, presenting products and applications, and building partnerships.

Adorned with the French Tech symbol, a large pink rooster, the building strengthens the network of tools already deployed around the Montpellier Méditerranée Métropole territory to favor innovation and company creation, in particular: startup incubators Cap Alpha and Cap Oméga, MIBI, and the LabSud fablab. The new building is a precursor of the flagship building that will rise in a few years near the TGV train station in Montpellier's new Cambacérès district.



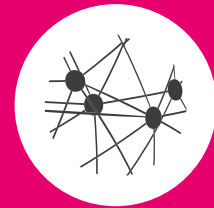
The building

The Montpellier French Tech Building is both a space for information and a site dedicated to promoting innovation and its applications for professionals and the general public. Designed for openness, the building fulfills several roles:



A WELCOMING PLACE

An interface for innovation, the French Tech Building welcomes companies and project leaders seeking information. It helps direct people towards the services and/or organizations likely to meet their needs. This space is also designed as a place to share and exchange ideas for startups hosted at the French Tech Building. Being near the Local Mission for Youth and the city's Youth Space represents an additional advantage, with the potential to help facilitate hiring and recognizing new talent.

A RELAY FOR INNOVATION STAKEHOLDERS

The French Tech Building offers a solid foundation for various types of stakeholders:

- Major schools in the digital field, including Up To, one of three programs now certified in Montpellier, provide training for various digital professions and focusing on specific learning environments.
- French Tech stakeholders such as competitiveness clusters, clusters, schools, universities, and research centers can benefit from this space to organize events and gatherings that contribute to the dissemination of knowledge.
- Entrepreneurs-students are assisted by PEPITE-LR (a student cluster for innovation, technology transfer, and entrepreneurship), led by the local community of universities and establishments (COMUE) known as "Languedoc-Roussillon Universités", for which the French Tech Building provides co-working areas.
- State administrative services provided by the Occitanie Region will set up their innovation laboratory in the heart of the startup ecosystem.



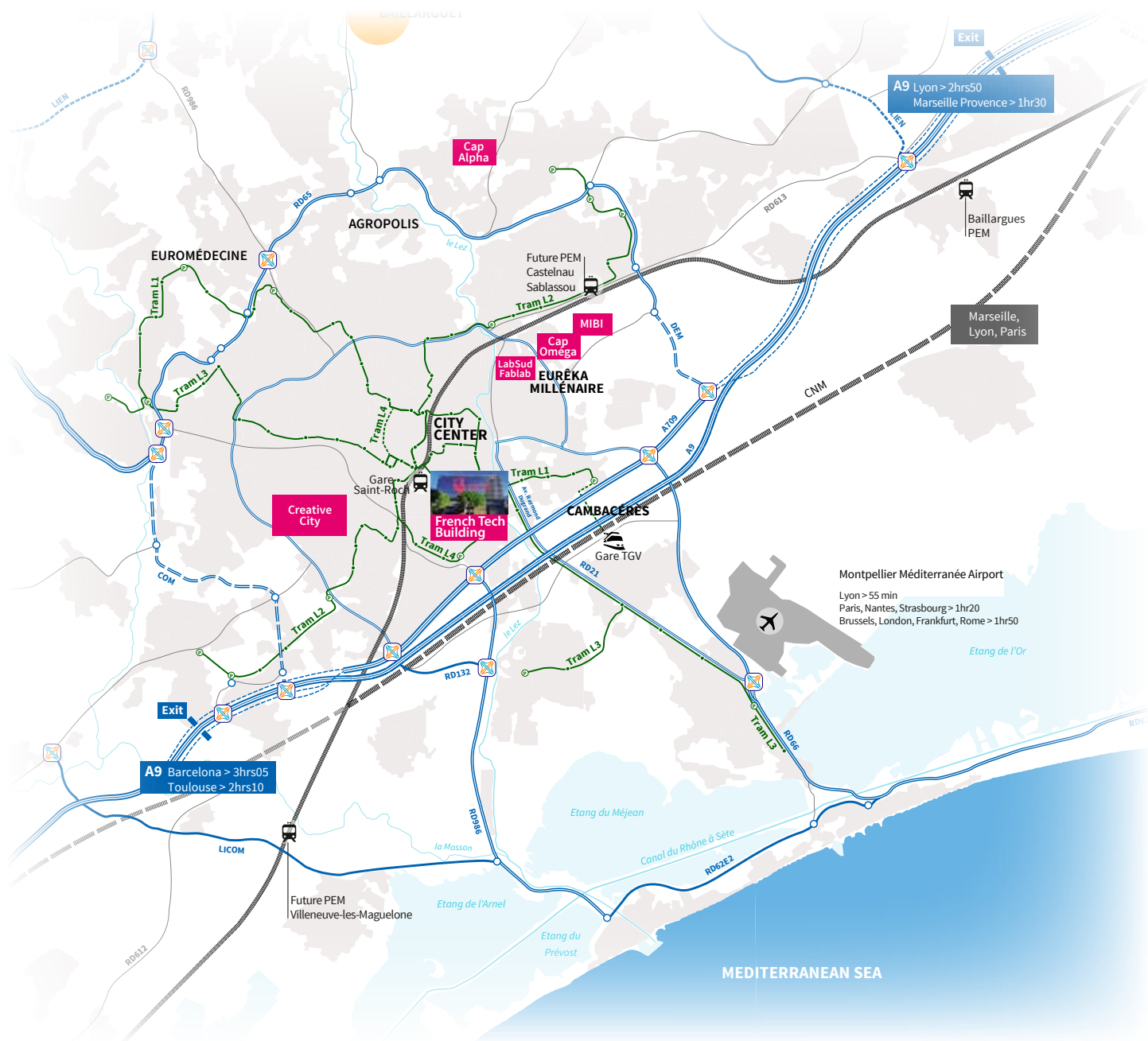
A SPACE FOR ACTIVITIES
