

- A 35,000-seat soccer stadium, a 12,000-seat rugby stadium, a network of 14 swimming pools, including an Olympic pool
- 4 tramway lines linking all these sites along 60 km of tracks, comprising one of the longest networks in France!



- Maguelone Cathedral, perched majestically on a peninsula between the sea and lagoon
- Medieval streets in Montpellier's central "Ecusson" area, a mikve Jewish ritual bath, and the Saint-Pierre Cathedral, all surrounding the oldest still-operating School of Medicine in the Western world
